

WATER AND SEWER CONNECTIONS POLICY

- Homeowner's contractor shall submit 2 sets of signed and sealed drawings to the building inspector in order to get a permit for tapping into our water and/or sewer system. When applying for the permit, the connection fees (or permit fees) of \$1,000 for water and \$1,000 for sewer shall be paid to the Village.
- After obtaining a permit, contractor shall coordinate with the DPW Superintendent a time for the work to be done and the Superintendent or the Deputy Superintendent will supervise the work.

OR

- If the homeowner or contractor does not wish to submit signed and sealed drawings and obtain a permit, they may hire the Village of Wilson to complete the work. That process will be as follows:
 - Pay the connection fee(s) at the Village Clerk's office.
 - After the fees have been paid, the DPW Superintendent will visit the job site and prepare a detailed, written estimate to complete the work. Depending on the location of the home, water main and sewer main the work could be quick and inexpensive or more costly and extensive. Each case is different and will be evaluated independently.
