§ 57-1. Burning leaves or rubbish.

No person shall start any fire or burn any paper, straw, wood, leaves, rubbish or other material on any street, public alley or public ground in the village.

§ 57-2. Penalties for offenses.¹

A violation of this chapter shall be punishable, upon conviction, by a fine or imprisonment, or both, as provided in Chapter 1, General Provisions, Article II.
